Payment of Tuition Fees

The College has partnered with Edstart to improve our College fee payment options. With Edstart Pay+, families will have access to more options with their fee payments, including:

- Options to pay weekly, fortnightly, monthly, termly or semesterly by selecting the schedule that works for you
- The ability to choose a preferred day for when payments are made
- The option to spread your fees during the year over a full 12-month period instead of 10 months
- The flexibility to adjust payments at any time

There are no fees or charges for using Edstart Pay+ for your Mandurah Baptist College Tuition Fees, subject levies and other activities.

The College will only accept upfront annual fee payments. Families wishing to pay by instalments are requested to set up their Edstart account by visiting www.edstart.com.au/mbc.

Secondary Assistance Scheme

The State Education Department offers a Secondary Assistance Scheme for the holders of a Centrelink Health Care Card, Pensioner, Concession Card or Veteran Affairs Pensioner Concession Card. Application forms are available from Administration, and some conditions do apply.

Absence from the College

No reduction of fees will be made on account of an absence from the College, for whatever reason, as the cost incurred in operating the College are not lessened by the absence of individual students.

Financial Hardship

Notice of Withdrawal

It is a condition of enrolment that one full term's notice of withdrawal of a student is given in writing. In the event that such notice is not given, a full term's tuition fee may apply.

Insurance

The College has a Student Accident Insurance Policy covering all enrolled students. Insurance is for College based activities only, including transport to and from external College events. Parents are advised to have comprehensive (24 hours per day) private health insurance in addition.
